Question 3: Answer the following.

1	Emma had 15 marbles, and she gave 6 marbles to her friend. How many marbles does she have now? Answer: 15 - 6 = 9 marbles
2	There are 23 students in the classroom. 8 students left for a field trip. How many students are still in the classroom? Answer: 23 - 8 = 15 students
3	Mia had 42 stickers, and she received 7 more stickers from her teacher. How many stickers does Mia have now? Answer: 42 + 7 = 49 stickers
4	Alex had 36 toy cars, but he lost 9 of them. How many toy cars does he have left? Answer: 36 - 9 = 27 toy cars
5	There were 54 apples in a basket. Then, 20 apples were taken for making a pie. How many apples are left in the basket? Answer: 54 - 20 = 34 apples
6	Emily had 28 pencils, and she gave 15 pencils to her classmates. How many pencils does Emily have now? Answer: 28 - 15 = 13 pencils
7	There were 67 books on the shelf. 23 books were borrowed by students. How many books are still on the shelf? Answer: 67 - 23 = 44 books
8	Liam has 51 candies. He shared 18 candies with his sister. How many candies does Liam have left? Answer: 51 - 18 = 33 candies
9	There are 39 children playing at the park. 14 children went home. How many children are still playing at the park? Answer: 39 - 14 = 25 children
10	Sophie had 60 stickers, and she bought 28 more stickers from the store. How many stickers does Sophie have now? Answer: 60 + 28 = 88 stickers
