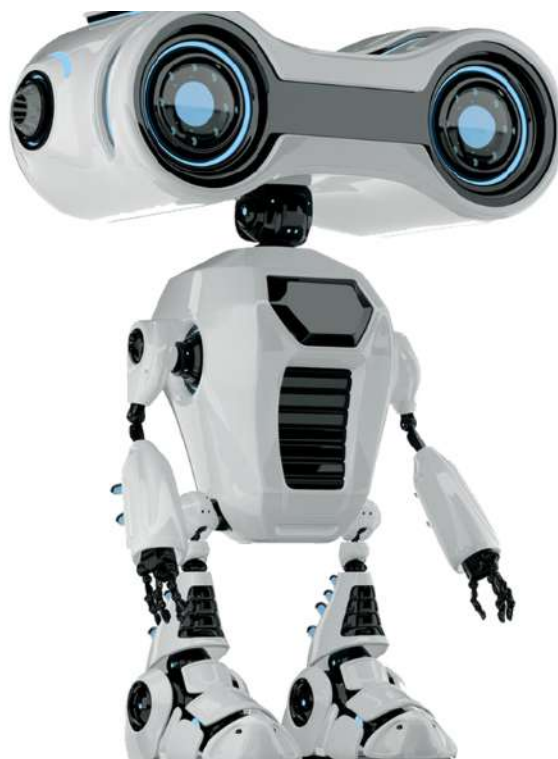




Year 5 Comprehension 5: The Robots Dream
