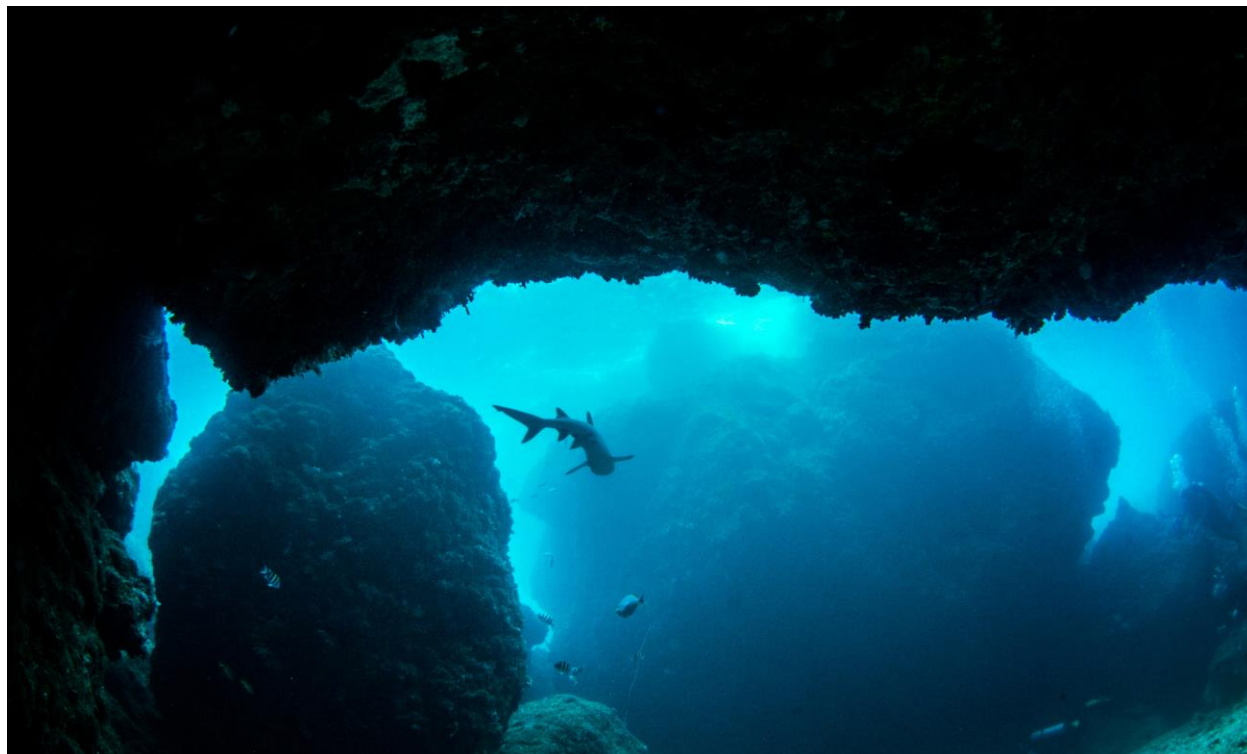




Year 6 Comprehension 12: Emma and the Cave of Sharks: A Dream Adventure
