4. Lily sees 6 butterflies in the garden. Later, she sees 5 more. How many butterflies did she see in total?

5. In a basket, there are 9 oranges. If I add 1 more orange, how many oranges are there?

6. Tom has 3 books. His friend gives him 4 more. How many books does Tom have now?

7. . There are 10 cookies on a plate. If I bake 5 more cookies, how many cookies are there?



8. Mia has 4 balloons. Her mother gives her 3 more balloons. How many balloons does Mia have now?

9. At the park, there are 6 swings. 3 more swings are added. How many swings are there in total?

10. There are 2 dogs and 5 cats in the yard. How many pets are there altogether?



Activity 2: Subtraction Word Problems

1. Mark has 10 candies. He eats 3 candies. How many candies does he have left?

2. There are 8 birds in the sky. 5 birds fly away. How many birds are still there?

3. Lucy has 12 stickers. She gives 4 stickers to her friend. How many stickers does she have now?

4. A farmer has 15 apples. He sells 7 apples. How many apples does he have left?

5. There are 9 children playing in the park. 2 of them go home. How many children are still playing?

6. Emma had 14 balloons, but 6 popped. How many balloons does she have now?

7. In a jar, there are 20 marbles. If I take out 5 marbles, how many marbles are left?

8. There are 11 ducks in a pond. 3 ducks swim away. How many ducks remain in the pond?



9. A bakery had 18 muffins. They sold 9 muffins. How many muffins are left?

10. There are 7 fish in a tank. If 2 fish are taken out, how many fish are in the tank now?
